### NOMINATION PROCEDURE

- ◆ Nominations will be judged on the selection criteria. Please address the nominee's accomplishments to those criteria.
- ◆ Nominations (up to 2 from each state in a Division) will be submitted from the Special Agents in Charge in each of DEA's 22 Field Divisions, and three nominations from the members of D.A.R.E.'s Law Enforcement Advisory Board. In addition, local D.A.R.E. Officers will also submit nominations for consideration through their respective DEA Demand Reduction Coordinators.
- ◆ Nomination submissions must include a bio of the nominee and a one-to- two pages, single-spaced narrative explaining why the nominee should be given the award. Narratives consisting of more than two pages (exclusive of the bio) will not be considered.
- ◆ All entries must be postmarked by **May 14, 2007**.
