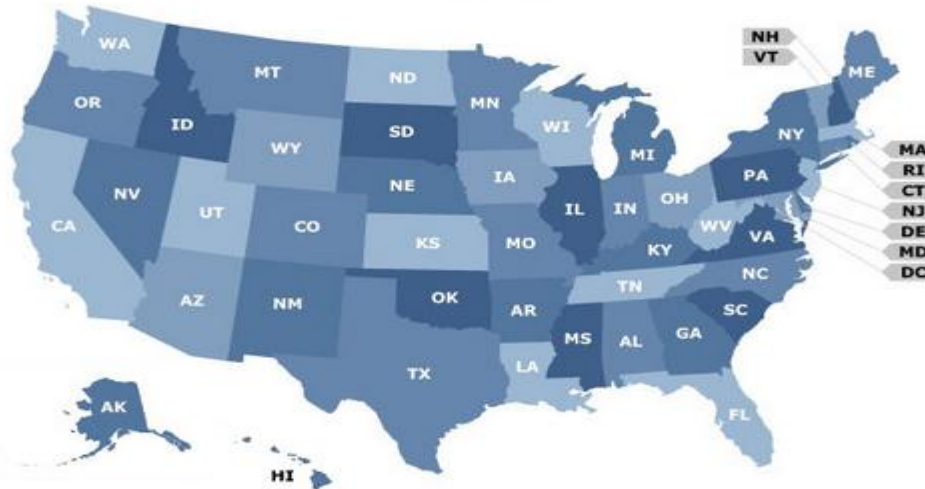

New Features

- **Fire Reports** – Insurance companies also purchase fire reports from municipal fire departments. In addition to crash reports, Docview eCommerce also has the capability to allow fire departments to upload/index fire reports.
- **Crime Reports** – Insurance companies also purchase selected crime reports from law enforcement agencies. Selected crime reports include larcenies, burglaries, stolen vehicles, malicious destructions and arson. Docview eCommerce also has the capability to allow insurance companies to purchase selected crime reports.
- **Citizen Self-Reporting** – Municipalities are also requesting applications that allow citizens to self-report online selected crash and incident reports. Private property or minor crash reports can be self-reported by citizens in lieu of sending an officer to the scene of the crash. The private property or minor crash reports are not reported to the State for statistical purposes. Minor incident reports may include smashed mail box, minor theft, barking dog complaint and other incidents in which it is not necessary for an officer to respond and take a report. Docview Citizen Self-Reporting application which is free for use by law enforcement agencies that utilize Docview's eCommerce
- **Public Minutes on Demand** – This application will allow Departments to upload their Agendas and Meeting Minutes (hard copy and video) and make the documents available to the public via the internet. Hard copy agendas and minutes will be run through an OCR process with allows users to perform key word searches on the documents. For example, if a citizen wanted to locate any archive city council minute involving a Community Park, then a search could be conducted on a key word. Many city council and other public meetings are video taped. Public Minutes on Demand will allow the videos to be uploaded and posted on a YouTube Channel that is setup for the City of Scottsdale.
- **Crash Mapping** – Docview is working with a vendor that will provide a module that will automatically perform mapping of crash locations. This will depict the hot spots for crashes.
