### Responsibilities

The Normandy Police Department serves the community by protecting citizens and property, preventing crime, enforcing laws, and maintaining order. Our Department's main goal is to contribute to the quality of life in Normandy and the partner communities we serve.

The Normandy Police Department is comprised of 29 full-time (reserves are authorized) sworn police officers that cover the residential and commercial areas around our City, including major interstate and state highways around our city and our contract patrols.

### Goals

The main goal of the Normandy Police Department is to create and maintain a safe, secure environment for all citizens. We strive to accomplish this goal through proactive community programs designed to prevent crime as well as efficient, thorough investigations of crimes committed.



### Employment Opportunities

The Normandy Police Department is always accepting applicants for the position of Police Officer. Solicited applications are kept on file for a year and unsolicited applications are kept for six months. Applications are available at City Hall; 7700 Natural Bridge Rd.

Starting salary: **\$46,000**

The City of Normandy currently offers a benefits package for all full-time employees. This package includes health and dental coverage for our employees and their families. The City also provides Basic and AD&D life insurance. Supplemental and dependent insurance is also offered at competitive rates. Optional insurance and benefits are available for full-time employees to purchase at their own expense.

### Employment Prerequisites

- Must be US citizen
- Must be 21 at time of commissioning
- Must have Class "A" P.O.S.T. certification, or be within 60 days of graduation from an accredited Police Academy.
- No felony convictions, serious misdemeanors, or DWI arrests
- Must be able to pass an extensive interview and background screening

- High school diploma/GED minimum, college preferred
