Bill Long Title

Requires a hearing to be held within 60 days if a state employee is placed on administrative leave

Modifies provisions relating to the Missouri local government employees' retirement system

Modifies provisions relating to ethics and repeals provisions of law deemed unconstitutional

Modifies the law relating to unemployment compensation benefits

Specifies that every child custody judgment must include a written statement notifying the parties that if a provision is violated, the court may modify the judgment

Expands the crime of sexual trafficking to include advertising a child participating in a commercial sexual act

Allows physicians to prescribe naloxone to any individual to administer, in good faith, to another individual suffering from an opioid overdose

Establishes the Rescue the Forgotten law to provide immunity from civil liability for persons who render assistance to a person in need
